- 6. Library News (Liaison) Val Devine:
 - Star Wars Day will be at the Slammers stadium rather than downtown due to ongoing street construction. She expressed thanks to the Friends for being an event sponsor and to those who are volunteering to help that day.
 - Posters are up at both branches for our May sale. Also, notices are being placed in the books on hold.
 - We have two options for donating the excess inventory left over after the sale: Will County Go Green and the book recycling event being held at Pilcher Park.

- Thrift report see the handout with notes from Val's conversation with our contact at Thrift. If we start using the large gators to collect the books we send to Thrift, we will need space to put the pallet. All the details will have to be determined after the BRB remodel is complete.
- The Library Administration is meeting later this month to discuss the remodel. We may know more about our future Friends space after that.
- Val attended a Zoom meeting for Friends of the Library groups on "Shaping the Future for your Friends." Please see Val if you would like information about the meeting and what ideas were discussed.
- Summer "Fests" downtown such as Kidzfest: We have not had a sale at this event in recent years because we did not make much money and ended up giving most of the books away.
 If we wish to participate, we could give vouchers for a free book from our ongoing sale.
 These vouchers can be given out at the Library's table.

7. Committee Reports:

- Membership We currently have 88 members.
 Wild Apricot There are some issues with the accounting system, and we need to update the password as they are starting to require 2 factor authentication. The monthly price has increased, and they will start charging us tax on the service unless we submit a non-profit form. A subcommittee of Paul, Dave, and Soren will investigate alternative software programs and report back to the group.
- Publicity As our liaison, Val gets posters made and put up. She also organizes the
 lawn signs for the sale. Marilyn suggested advertising on the Joliet Patch website. All of
 us can "like" and "share" the Library's Facebook posts about the upcoming book sales –
 which will increase our publicity.

8. Old Business

- Donations The question was raised whether we want to limit donations from the public during the remodel as we are short on storage space. Often people don't read the website info about what we accept, and many don't ask before they drop off books, etc. We scan donated books to see if they have value for Thrift. Once the remodel is complete, we could put a free table in the community room at BRB to give away things we cannot sell. Also, we can have a box or bin for recycling at both locations and let the maintenance staff know to empty it when full. If we get overwhelmed with donations and deleted books, Val will ask Joe if we can use the area right outside our room in the basement at OSB to store boxes of books.
- Thrift analysis already discussed

9. New Business

- Possible Fundraisers Paul distributed a list of ideas for fundraising at the last meeting, and ideas were briefly discussed then. We would need volunteers to coordinate future fundraisers. We can plan to do a restaurant fundraiser the week after our fall sale so we can post and give out promotional fliers at the sale. If we need to increase our revenue to assist with more projects (such as the BRB remodel), we can explore other kinds of fundraisers beyond our book sales and restaurant fundraisers.
- Birthday Celebration We tried to have a 50th Anniversary celebration in 2018. We ended up serving cake and playing music from 1968 at our regular book sale. We also offered a special price (\$50) for lifetime memberships. The next likely opportunity to celebrate the founding of the Friends of the JPL will be in 2028 for the 60th Anniversary.

- Book sale volunteer sign-up sheet was passed around for people to indicate when they can help. Set up will be on Thursday and Friday. We can request some high school students to help on Friday after 3 p.m.
