

Safety of Minors Policy

The Joliet Public Library encourages children of all ages to visit the Library with their parents to take advantage of the resources available for them. The Library endeavors to provide a welcoming, pleasant, and safe environment for all Library users. However, parents or guardians are responsible for the health, safety, behavior, and well-being of their children, whether the parent, guardian, or caregiver is present or not. Children age eight and under must be accompanied and directly supervised by a parent or other responsible caregiver age 14 or older at all times while on Library property. Children ages 9 and older are permitted to be in the library without the direct supervision of a parent or responsible caregiver age 14 and older. The Joliet Public Library assumes neither responsibility nor liability for the actions, care, supervision, or safety of minors.
