Non-residents can apply for library cards and will be charged an annual fee based on their tax bill or yearly rent. Children may apply for their own library card with parental consent. Cards for children 0-17 are free.

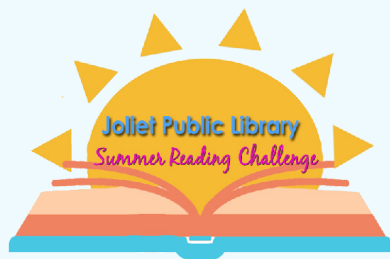
