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Get a Library Card

City of Joliet residents may apply for a library card at the Circulation desk. You must present a current government issue photo ID that verifies your name and current address, or a general photo ID and proof of residency. Non-residents can apply for library cards and will be charged an annual fee based on their tax bill or yearly rent. Children 3+ years old may apply for their own library card with parental consent.

Residents of Joliet Township and Rockdale who are students of Joliet Public Schools, Rockdale Grade School, Troy CCSD 30C, Plainfield School District 202 and Laraway CCSD70C are eligible for Student Cards at no additional cost to the household.
